

VISITOR REGULATIONS

Dear visitors,

we warmly welcome you to the Woods Art Institute and wish you a pleasant and stimulating stay. In order to do justice to all visitors and their interests and to ensure the safety of the exhibits, certain rules are essential. The visitor regulations are binding for all guests. By purchasing your admission ticket, you automatically agree to our regulations.

1. To protect the objects shown in the exhibitions, heavy outer clothing and bulky items such as backpacks, umbrellas, hiking sticks, sports equipment, suitcases and larger bags must remain in the cloakroom. Lockers are available free of charge.
2. Touching works of art and showcases is prohibited. Please keep a distance of at least 50 cm from the exhibits.
3. It is not allowed to eat or drink in the exhibition rooms. Persons who are clearly under the influence of alcohol can be denied access to the collection rooms.
4. Smoking is prohibited in all buildings.
5. Animals may not be taken along. Designated therapy and assistance dogs are excluded.
6. Photography and filming - exclusively for private, non-commercial purposes - is permitted as long as the safety of the art is guaranteed and a minimum distance of 50 cm is maintained. This permission does not apply to third party rights. We expressly point out that the depiction or distribution of content protected by copyright or personal rights is subject to approval. Written approval is required for all purposes that go beyond the general permission, this also applies to subsequent changes in use.
7. We warmly welcome families to the WAI Galleries and WAI Park and ask that those accompanying them ensure the safety of the artworks and show consideration for other visitors. Running and romping around in the house is not permitted. **Sculptures may not be touched or climbed on! Parents pay attention to their children at all times.**
8. The management staff is instructed and authorized to ensure compliance with the visitor regulations. If the visitor regulations are violated, further stays in the WAI Galleries and in the WAI Park can be prohibited without compensation.

Visitors are therefore obliged:

- to follow the instructions of the managerial staff.
- to supervise children.
- in the case of school groups, the accompaniment of one to ensure responsibility.
- to move around the exhibition spaces in such a way as to avoid damaging works of art.

Visitors are liable for all expenses and damage caused by disregarding the visitor regulations.
